SUBJECT WITH THE LICENCE

➔ COPYING AND PRINTING FROM OPEN WEBSITES

20 images or pages that when printed match the A4 sheet size/webpage

An entire scientific article

NOTE MATERIAL:
10 pages / webpage

E- BOOKS: 20 pages/publication but no more than 20 % of the publication

➔ SCANNING

20 pages / publication, but no more than 20 % of the publication

An entire scientific article

NOTE MATERIAL:
10 pages / publication, but no more than half of the publication

10 % of an SFS-standard, however no more than 20 pages

➔ PHOTOCOPYING

20 pages / publication, but no more than half of the publication

NOTE MATERIAL:
10 pages / publication, but no more than half of the publication

10 % of an SFS-standard, however no more than 20 pages

➔ COPYING FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES

To the extent required for the purpose

➔ DISTRIBUTION OF DIGITAL COPIES

Materials may be distributed to a teaching group or research team via a closed network or e-mail. Students may be given access to the materials for the duration of a course.

Digital materials subject to a charge or registration
Finnish playscripts
International standards
Music, AV materials and computer softwares
